

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

### MAHLE ECO RALLYE COMUNITAT VALENCIANA

#### 1. Event Profile

The MAHLE Eco Rallye Comunitat Valenciana is one of the leading sustainable mobility competitions in Spain and an international benchmark within the FIA EcoRallye Cup calendar since 2018. Since its creation in 2014, the event has evolved into a pioneering platform promoting electric mobility, efficient driving and sustainability through sport.

#### 2. Mission, Vision and Values

##### Mission

To promote electric mobility, efficient driving and sustainability through sport, within the framework of an original and innovative competition.

##### Vision

To be a national and international benchmark as a sporting event in the field of sustainable mobility and a platform for the promotion of alternative energies.

##### Values

The MAHLE Eco Rallye Comunitat Valenciana combines the core values of sport with principles of sustainability, environmental protection, innovation and awareness.

#### 3. Environmental Policy

The organisation of the MAHLE Eco Rallye Comunitat Valenciana is committed to integrating sustainability into the overall strategy of the event, generating environmental, social and economic value while minimising its impact, within the framework of the FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme and in compliance with applicable Spanish regulations related to sustainability and the organisation of sporting events.

To achieve this, the organisation commits to:

- Comply with all applicable environmental regulations and FIA Environmental Accreditation requirements.
- Prevent pollution and minimise environmental impacts associated with the event.
- Establish environmental objectives focused on continuous improvement.
- Calculate the event's carbon footprint annually using recognised methodologies.

- Reduce emissions and compensate residual carbon footprint through certified carbon credits.
- Promote the use of renewable energy in vehicle charging processes.
- Encourage sustainable mobility through the use of electrified vehicles within the organisation.
- Minimise resource consumption by prioritising reusable materials and digital solutions.
- Implement selective waste collection systems across key operational areas.
- Reduce single-use plastics through reusable solutions.
- Work with suppliers and promote sustainability criteria in procurement.
- Raise awareness among participants, staff and the public regarding environmental best practices.
- Protect natural environments along the route in coordination with relevant authorities.

#### **4. Environmental Management and Monitoring**

In addition to the commitments above, the organisation adopts a progressively structured environmental management approach based on monitoring, measurement and continuous improvement.

This includes:

- Annual carbon footprint assessment.
- Monitoring of energy consumption, particularly vehicle charging.
- Collection of operational data related to suppliers, logistics and waste management.
- Annual review of environmental performance to identify improvement opportunities.

All relevant documentation is stored digitally and used to support continuous improvement.


The organisation is also committed to progressively strengthening its environmental management approach through structured monitoring, measurement and review of its environmental performance.

This includes the annual evaluation of environmental data, particularly carbon footprint results, energy consumption and operational impacts, in order to identify opportunities for improvement and support continuous development in line with the FIA Environmental Accreditation Programme.

## 5.5. Communication and Review

This Environmental Policy is communicated to all members of the organisation, participants and the public, and is publicly available on the event's official website.

The organisation periodically reviews this policy to ensure its continued relevance and effectiveness.
